PERMANENT ORDINANCE NO. 12-11

AN ORDINANCE TO DETACH FROM THE CITY OF LANCASTER 7.117 ACRES AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster and Fairfield County Commissioners have developed a plan to relocate Election House Road to accommodate the Fairfield County Airport; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster and Fairfield County Commissioners desire to plan for clear boundary lines for road maintenance and safety forces; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster and Fairfield County Commissioners through their engineers allocated responsibilities in this project; and

WHEREAS, the Law Director was asked to proceed with de-annexation of a portion of the project to prevent the need for a roadway maintenance agreement;

WHEREAS, the Fairfield County Commissioners own said parcel;

WHEREAS, the land petition is to detach 7.117 acres of land as part of this collaborative project;

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code 709.38 permits such detachment;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Lancaster, State of Ohio

SECTION 1. That an application by the Fairfield County Commissioners has been presented to this Council for the detachment of the following described territory from the City of Lancaster of Fairfield County, Ohio: a tract which is comprised of 7.117 acres, Section 27 of Township 15, Range 19, Fairfield County, Ohio see attached Exhibit "A" and "B" for description. The petition is attached as Exhibit C.

SECTION 2. The Council of the City of Lancaster hereby assents and grants the Petition to De-Annex for the parcel described in Exhibit A & B.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City and for the further reason that this Ordinance is required to be immediately effective in order to clarify the boundaries of the City for clarity in provision of emergency services including police and fire for the property, wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

SITUATE IN THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 15, RANGE 19, CITY OF LANCASTER, GREENFIELD TOWNSHIP, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO.

Being a part of a 7.259 acre tract of land described in official record 1553, page 2960 owned by the Board of Commissioners of Fairfield County, Ohio and being more fully described as follows:

Commencing for reference at a railroad spike found in the northwest corner of the northeast quarter of section 27 and being also in the center of Election House Road;

thence, South $03^{\circ}-00'-16''$ West, 672.77 feet, along the westerly line of the northeast quarter of section 27 and the centerline of Election House Road, to a $5/8$ inch diameter rebar with I.D. cap found;

thence, South $86^{\circ}-25'-16''$ East, 22.50 feet, along the grantor's north line, to a $5/8$ inch diameter rebar with I.D. cap set at the intersection of same with the east right of way line of Election House Road and the current westerly corporation line of the City of Lancaster, and being the principal place of beginning of the tract herein de-annexed;

thence, South $86^{\circ}-25'-16''$ East, 1259.68 feet, along the grantor's north line and current north corporation line of the City of Lancaster, to a $5/8$ inch diameter rebar with I.D. cap found at the northwest corner of lot number 601 of River Valley Highlands, Section 8, Phase 2 as filed in Plat Cabinet 2, slot 14;

thence, South $03^{\circ}-29'-07''$ West, 245.83 feet, along the west line of River Valley Highlands, Section 8, Phase 2, to a $5/8$ inch diameter rebar with I.D. cap found;

thence, North $86^{\circ}-27'-11''$ West, 1242.67 feet, to a $5/8$ inch diameter rebar with I.D. cap found;

thence, Southwesterly, 31.57 feet, along the proposed southeasterly right of way line of Election House Road and the arc of a curve to the left having a radius of 37.80 feet, an internal angle of

47°-50'-55" and a chord 30.66 feet in length bearing South 26°-55'-44" West, to a 5/8 inch diameter rebar with I.D. cap found;

thence, North 86°-59'-44" West, 2.50 feet, to the intersection of same with the east right of way line of Election House Road and the current west corporation line of the City of Lancaster;

thence, North 03°-00'-16" East, 274.71 feet, along the east right of way line of Election House Road and the current west corporation line of the City of Lancaster, to the principal place of beginning;

Containing 7.117 acres more or less and being subject to any legal highways and easements of record.

Rebars set are 5/8 inch diameter by 30 inches in length with yellow plastic I.D. cap stamped with CHOICE ONE ENGR SEB LS-7059.



PLAT OF DE-ANNEXATION





PLAT OF DE-ANNEXATION


SECTION 27 TOWNSHIP 15 N RANGE 19 W LANCASTER GREENFIELD FAIRFIELD OHIO COUNTY
