**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT TO THE U. S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT LANCASTER'S FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2012 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ANNUAL PLAN AND STATEMENT OF OBJECTIVES**

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster will receive an entitlement allocation of \$436,878 in FY 2012 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding, in addition to anticipated housing rehabilitation/acquisition revolving loan program income of \$7,1222; and

WHEREAS, the city has prepared its FY 2012 Annual Plan to be consistent with the city's Consolidated Housing and Community Development Plan FY 2008 - FY 2012 which identifies housing and non-housing community development needs; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2012 Annual Plan and Program has been developed in accordance with Lancaster's Citizen Participation Plan, including two public hearings conducted on March 26, 2012, and May 14 2012, along with a publication of a summary of the proposed Annual Action Plan for public comment.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO**

SECTION 1. The FY 2012 CDBG Annual Plan and Statement of Objectives and Use of Funds is hereby approved, as attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor of the City of Lancaster is hereby designated as the official representative of the grantee and authorized to submit the Annual Plan and all certifications, assurances, and related documents to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), and to act in connection with the submission as may be necessary.

SECTION 3. That the Mayor of the City of Lancaster is hereby authorized to execute the FY 2012 CDBG Grant Agreement with the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and to administer the Community Development Block Grant Program on behalf of the city.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
