

TEMPORARY RESOLUTION NO. 140-12

PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR AND THE AUDITOR TO IDENTIFY GENERAL FUND MONEY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$150,000.00) FOR THE PAYMENT OF RECENT STORM CLEAN-UP COSTS INCURRED INCLUDING REPLENISHMENT OF THE TREE COMMISSION FUND WITH THE EXPECTATION OF REIMBURSEMENT BY FEMA.

WHEREAS, storms recently caused substantial tree and debris damage in the City of Lancaster which has necessitated substantial monetary expenditures for clean-up; and

WHEREAS, the City needs additional general fund money to pay for the clean-up costs being incurred, and

WHEREAS, the City anticipates some level of reimbursement of these clean-up costs by FEMA.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Lancaster, State of Ohio;

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director and the Auditor shall identify general fund money in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) to be used to pay storm damage clean-up costs currently being incurred and to replenish the Tree Commission Fund with the expectation of some level of reimbursement by FEMA of the storm damage costs incurred.

SECTION 2. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City; wherefore, this resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
