A RESOLUTION TO DECREASE AND INCREASE APPROPRIATIONS IN VARIOUS ACCOUNTS WITHIN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND ISSUE A THEN AND NOW CERTIFICATE

WHEREAS, the Police Department received a Drug Use Prevention Program Grant for the 2011/2012 grant year.
