PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 109-12

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONSULTING ENGINEERING AGREEMENT FOR THE UNION STREET STORM SEWER DESIGN

Whereas, the City of Lancaster is required to control and eliminate Combined Sewer Overflows under the NPDES permit issued by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency; and

Whereas, the Union Street combined sewer discharges to CSO 1011, and

Whereas, installation of a new storm sewer on Union Street will allow the City to close CSO 1011; and

Whereas, construction of the storm sewer must be completed before paving of Columbus Street in 2013;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director be and is hereby authorized to enter into a consulting engineering agreement for design services not to exceed \$50,000 for the Union Street Storm Sewer.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
