A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATIONS WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR AND APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE IN THE GENERAL FUND (101)

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster Code Enforcement Officer due to the large amount of high grass abatements and the early growing season Code Enforcement is requesting an additional \$5,000.00 appropriation to the Enforcement of property maintenance; and

WHEREAS, Monies used for nuisance abatement are assessed to the property taxes along with a \$75.00 administrative fee; and

WHEREAS, Once the property is sold the special assessment has to be paid before a deed transfer can occur;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Appropriations with the County Auditor in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) in the General Fund (101).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance in General Fund (101) into expense account 101.181.5229 (Code Enforcement) in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
