

TEMPORARY RESOLUTION NO. 132-12

PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 139-12

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE FAIRFIELD COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE FOR THE ETY ROAD BRIDGE REPLACEMENTS AND STREET REHABILITATION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO.

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the Fairfield County Engineer's Office for the following:

The City will be the Local Public Agency of record for the project;

The City will authorize its allocation of federal surface transportation program funds to cover 80% of the project's construction costs for the replacement of both bridges and the street rehabilitation work;

The Fairfield County Engineer's Office will provide the local 20% match of the project's construction costs for the replacement of both bridges and the street rehabilitation work;

The Fairfield County Engineer's Office will prepare all environmental documents and obtain all required permits;

The Fairfield County Engineer's Office will prepare construction drawings of the proposed work for the entire project;

The City will prepare the bidding and contract documents for the entire project;

The City will provide necessary right-of-way from its adjoining property at no cost to the Fairfield County Engineer;

The Fairfield County Engineer's Office will provide resident inspection and construction management services during the construction phase of the project;

The Fairfield County Engineer's Office agrees to abide by all federal regulations and policies mandated of the Local Public Agency in the inspection and management of the project work.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
