A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A LPA FEDERAL LOCAL-LET PROJECT AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF OHIO, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPLACING A DETERIORATED CULVERT UNDER BREMEN ROAD, STATE ROUTE 37

WHEREAS, the City has available to it Federal Surface Transportation Program Funds to use on eligible streets in the City; and

WHEREAS, Bremen Road, State Route 37, is an eligible street for the utilization of those Federal Surface Transportation Program Funds, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement project herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a LPA Federal Local Let Project Agreement with the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation for the purpose of replacing a deteriorated culvert and other ancillary work on portions of Bremen Road, State Route 37.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
