A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A LPA FEDERAL LOCAL-LET PROJECT AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF OHIO, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPLACING A DETERIORATED BRIDGE ON SOUTH COLUMBUS STREET

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation has federal funds available under its Municipal Bridge Replacement Program to provide funding to replace eligible bridges in Cities; and

WHEREAS, the South Columbus Street bridge is an eligible bridge for the utilization of said Municipal Bridge Program funds; and

WHEREAS, the City has applied for and received a grant of said Municipal Bridge Program funds for the replacement of the South Columbus Street bridge over Tarhe Run; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement project herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a LPA Federal Local-LET Project Agreement with the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation for the purpose of replacing a deteriorated bridge and other ancillary work on South Columbus Street.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
