

TEMPORARY RESOLUTION NO. 78-11

PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 76-11

A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS AND TO AMEND THE CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATIONS WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR

WHEREAS, a sinkhole has threatened the property at 808 West Hubert Avenue due to a failed private storm sewer; and,

WHEREAS, this private storm sewer carried flow from a public culvert on Spring Street; and

WHEREAS, an emergency has been created making it necessary to immediately divert the flow from the public culvert to a new storm sewer to allow the private property owners to take action to remove or replace the private storm system to protect the property for the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of the Corporation of the City of Lancaster and the public in general; and

WHEREAS, due to this emergency the requisite time for competitive bidding is not available due to the emergency;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, OHIO

SECTION 1: The Service Safety Director is authorized to waive competitive bidding and enter into a contract not to exceed \$100,000.00 for the installation of the storm sewer from west of Mitoff Drive to Houfek Dr.

SECTION 2: From monies now on hand estimated to come into the Stormwater Fund to increase the appropriation in 606-640-5912 Transfer to Improvement Fund by the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000).

SECTION 3: That the Auditor of the City of Lancaster amend the Certificate of Appropriation with the County Auditor in Fund 606 (Stormwater) by One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00).

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
