PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 42-10

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO WAIVE COMPETITIVE BIDS AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR REPAIR OF THE WHEELING STREET STORM SEWER FOR AN EMERGENCY REPAIR OF A COLLAPSED LINE

WHEREAS, during TV inspection of the Wheeling Street Storm Sewer it was discovered that a portion of the storm sewer had collapsed requiring immediate repair; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation during the investigation of the line determined that the line was not located in the tree lawn as shown on plans but actually under the water distribution building; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to replace the storm sewer immediately to protect the adjacent water wells and distribution building as well as to avoid delay on the sewer lignin project; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to make these repairs immediately for the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of the Corporation of the City of Lancaster and the public in general;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to waive competitive bidding and enter into a contract for the replacement of the Wheeling Street Storm Sewer between Memorial Drive and the Hocking River.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
