PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 59-10

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO DISPENSE WITH BIDDING BY PURCHASING FROM THE STATE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM BY ENTERING INTO A CONTRACT WITH STRAWSER CONSTRUCTION INC, TO PERFORM THE SAMI AND MICRO APPLICATIONS ON THE VAN BUREN/MAUD/BRUMFIELD PROJECTS, AND REQUESTING THE LANCASTER PORT AUTHORITY TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS

WHEREAS, purchases off of the State Cooperative Purchasing Program are exempt from the bid requirements;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the certificate with the County Auditor for Fund 208 in the amount of \$65,000.00.

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor update receipts for 208.000.4609 from the Lancaster Port Authority for \$65,000.00.

SECTION 3. That the City of Lancaster Auditor Appropriate from unappropriated 208.750.5203 in the amount of \$65,000.00.

SECTION 4. That Lancaster City Council requests the Treasurer of the Lancaster Port Authority to pay to the City of Lancaster the sum of Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000.00), as funds become available and under the direction of the Treasurer.

SECTION 5. That from monies now on hand and estimated to come into the City of Lancaster, Account Number 208.000.4609 from the Lancaster Port Authority there be and is hereby appropriated to the Department of Transportation the sum of Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000.00) to Account Number 208.750.5203, Contract Labor.

SECTION 6. That the Service-Safety Director dispense with competitive bidding and enter into a contract with Strawser Construction, Inc, to perform SAMI and Micro applications on Van Buren/Maud/Brumfield Projects.

SECTION 7. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
