A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CENTRAL COLLECTION AGENCY FOR THE COLLECTION OF PAST DUE TAX DOLLARS AND NON-FILE DELINQUENCY ISSUES

WHEREAS, Permanent Ordinance 21-09 authorized the use of a collection agency for collecting unpaid income tax owed to the City of Lancaster; and

WHEREAS, the this will be a lengthy process taking approximately four to six months set up; and

WHEREAS, the Income Tax Department would like to move forward at this time prior to the next tax season when the Department becomes very busy;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Central Collection Agency to help with non-file delinquency issues and past due tax dollar issues.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from passage and approval by the Mayor.
