A RESOLUTION TO CREATE A NEW FUND FOR 911 TARIFF (723)

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster receives 911 Tariff monies due to House Bill 361 which created a funding mechanism for establishing wireless enhanced 9-1-1 service in Ohio. Under Section 4931.64 of the Ohio Revised Code states that we may use disbursements to pay any of its personnel costs of one or more public safety answering points providing countywide wireless enhanced 9-1-1;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor establish a new fund for the 911 Tariff (Fund 723) and create expense accounts 723.328.5102 (Salaries), 723.328.5103 (Overtime), 723.328.5105 (Sick Buyout), 723.328.5150 (Employer Pension), 723.328.5151 (Pension Pickup), 723.328.5152 (Health Insurance), 723.328.5153 (Medicare), 723.328.5154 (Uniform Allowance).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Other Resources and Appropriation with the County Auditor by giving them this newly established 911 Tariff Fund (723).

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
