A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT FOR THE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT KNOWN AS FAI-SOUTH COLUMBUS STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

WHEREAS, the South Columbus Street Bridge over Tarhe Run is in poor condition and needs replaced; and

WHEREAS, the there exists a real and present need to perform the improvement project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Lancaster has previously passed Permanent Resolution Number 2-11 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a LPA Federal Local-Let Agreement with said Department of Transportation for the purpose of constructing the improvement project herein above described; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Lancaster has previously passed Permanent Resolution Number 67-11 authorizing the Service-Safety Director to advertise for bids and enter into a construction agreement for the project known as FAI – SOUTH COLUMBUS STREET BRIDGE, however, no bids were received during this letting;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO.

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a construction agreement with the lowest and best bidder to complete the project FAI – SOUTH COLUMBUS STREET BRIDGE, PID 85871 in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Ninety-Six Thousand Dollars (\$396,000.00).

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
