PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 37-16

A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE IN GENERAL FUND (101), INCREASE RECEIPTS, APPROPRIATE FROM UNENCUMBERED BALANCE IN THE .45 POLICE & FIRE LEVY FUND (247) AND AMEND THE CERTIFICATE WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR

WHEREAS, The Police Department received \$17,677.00 for settlement/restitution for the 2014 Dodge Charger that was totaled on January 2, 2016 in a traffic crash. The Police Department would like to appropriate the money that was paid into the General Fund into their Vehicles expense account in the .45 Police & Fire Levy Fund (247);

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the certificate of appropriations with the County Auditor for the General Fund (101) in the amount of Seventeen Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Seven Dollars (\$17,677.00).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance in the General Fund (101) into expense account 101.000.5907 (Transfer/.45% Voter Approved Levy) in the amount of Seventeen Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Seven Dollars (\$17,677.00).

SECTION 3. That the City of Lancaster Auditor increase receipts (estimated revenue) in the .45 Police & Fire Levy Fund (247) in revenue account 247.000.4986 (Transfers/General Fund) in the amount of Seventeen Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Seven Dollars (\$17,677.00).

SECTION 4. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance in the .45 Police & Fire Levy Fund (247) in expense account 247.325.5650 (Vehicle) in the amount of Seventeen Thousand Six Hundred Seventy Seven Dollars (\$17,677.00).

SECTION 5. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Other Sources and Appropriations with the County Auditor in the amount of Seventeen Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Seven Dollars (\$17,677.00) in the .45 Police & Fire Levy Fund (247).

SECTION 6. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
