PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 102-16

A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE, AND AMEND THE CERTIFICATE WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR IN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND (320)

WHEREAS, this new vehicle will replace a 1999 Chevy Astro Van for the transportation of prisoners to and from court and could also act as a paddy wagon if several arrests were made at the same time;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Appropriations with the County Auditor in the amount of Thirty-Nine Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-Seven Dollars (\$39,277.00) in the Capital Improvement Fund (320).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance in the expense account 320.925.5650 (Vehicles) for the amount of Thirty-Nine Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-Seven Dollars (\$39,277.00) in the Capital Improvement Fund (320) for the purchase of a new prisoner transport van for use by the Lancaster Police Department.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
