A RESOLUTION OF CONSENT FOR THE EMERGENCY REPAIR OF THE WILSON ROAD (CR 45) BRIDGE OVER US 33 IN THE CITY OF LANCASTER TO REPAIR DAMAGE SUFFERED BY THE BRIDGE AFTER BEING STRUCK

WHEREAS, this legislation is enacted by the Lancaster City Council of Fairfield County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency (LPA), in the matter of the stated described project; and

WHEREAS, the LPA has identified the need for the described project; and

WHEREAS, said portion of described project is within the Lancaster City Council area of responsibility;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. Project Description:

The project is for the emergency repair of the Wilson Road (CR 45) bridge over US 33 in the City of Lancaster to repair damage suffered by the bridge after being struck. This work will be performed as part of PID 105486, FAI-US 33-11.58.

SECTION 2. Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

SECTION 3. Cooperation Statement

The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

The City grants the Ohio Department of Transportation authorization to take action required to make safe the situation and then make repairs to the structure and return it to normal operating condition.

ODOT shall assume and bear 100% of the necessary costs of the State's highway improvement project. In the event that the LPA requests certain features or appurtenances be included within the States highway improvement project's design and construction, and which features and appurtenances are determined by the State and FHWA to be not necessary for the State's project, the LPA shall contribute 100% of the cost of those items.

SECTION VI - Authority to Sign

The Service-Safety Director, Paul Martin of the City of Lancaster is hereby designated and empowered on behalf of LPA to enter into agreements with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.

SECTION V. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
