AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF UNCLAIMED PROPERTY IN THE POSSESSION OF THE LANCASTER POLICE DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 737.32 provides that the Chief of Police may donate or contribute property in the possession of the Police Department, that remains unclaimed for ninety (90) days or more, to one or more public agencies and/or nonprofit organizations if authorized by ordinance adopted by the legislative authority of the municipal corporation for property not regulated for disposal by other sections of the Ohio Revised Code;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That City Council hereby authorizes the Chief of Police to donate or contribute property in the possession of the Police Department, that remains unclaimed for ninety (90) days or more, to one or more public agencies and/or nonprofit organizations pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 737.32.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
