

TEMPORARY RESOLUTION NO. 75-17

PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 79-17

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE CERTIFICATE OF OTHER SOURCES AND APPROPRIATIONS WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR, TO INCREASE RECEIPTS, AND APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE IN THE MUNICIPAL COURT JUDICIAL PROBATION FUND (235)

WHEREAS, Fairfield County Municipal Court began providing drug testing services to Fairfield County Common Pleas Court defendants as a pilot project in 2016; and

WHEREAS, the program has been successful and highly satisfactory to Fairfield County Common Pleas Court and they have begun sending more defendants to Fairfield County Municipal Court for testing, which has resulted in costs savings to Fairfield County Common Pleas Court; and

WHEREAS, no revenues were anticipated for 2017, as receipts were minimal in 2016. To date in 2017, approximately Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00) has been paid in to the fund; and

WHEREAS, because of the increased drug testing, Fairfield County Municipal Court has needed to order more reagents and drug testing supplies than in the past, creating a need to increase appropriations in the supplies line item;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor increase receipts in revenue account 235.000.4328 (Municipal Court Judicial Probation Fund) by Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance in the Fund (235) into expense account 235.252.5300 (Probation/Supplies) in the amount of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00).

SECTION 3. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Other Sources and Appropriations with the County for Fund (235) in the amount of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00).

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
