A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER ADOPTING THE 2017 FAIRFIELD COUNTY NATURAL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN, AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Lancaster City Council recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the City of Lancaster; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster has prepared multi-hazard mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long term risk to people and property in the City of Lancaster from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, the Fairfield County 2017 Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan, identifies mitigation goals and action to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the City of Lancaster from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, adoption by Lancaster City Council demonstrates Lancaster's commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the 2017 Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. Lancaster City Council hereby adopts the Fairfield County 2017 Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan.

SECTION 2. That for the reasons noted in the preamble, this resolution is declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Lancaster, Ohio. Therefore, this resolution shall become effective upon its passage by Council and signature of the Mayor.
