A RESOLUTION TO INCREASE RECEIPTS, APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE AND AMEND THE CERTIFICATE WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR AND .45 POLICE & FIRE LEVY FUND (247)

WHEREAS, the Fire Department is anticipating the receipt of funds from the Ohio Department of Public Safety for the 2016-2017 Training and Equipment Grant in the amount of Two Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$2,750.00), and the EMS 2017-2018 Priority One Grant in the amount of Three Thousand Twenty-Five Dollars (\$3,025.00); and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department would like to have these funds transferred from the General Fund to their Medical Supplies Account;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the certificate of appropriations with the County Auditor for the General Fund (101) in the amount of Five Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars (\$5,775.00).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance in the General Fund (101) into expense account 101.000.5907 (Transfer/.45% Voter Approved Levy) in the amount of Five Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars (\$5,775.00).

SECTION 3. That the City of Lancaster Auditor increase receipts (estimated revenue) in the .45 Police & Fire Levy Fund (247) in revenue account 247.000.4986 (Transfers/General Fund) in the amount of Five Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars (\$5,775.00).

SECTION 4. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance in the .45 Police & Fire Levy Fund (247) in expense account 247.350.5316 (Medical Supplies) in the amount of Five Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars (\$5,775.00).

SECTION 5. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Other Sources and Appropriations with the County Auditor in the amount of Five Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars (\$5,775.00) in the .45 Police & Fire Levy Fund (247).

SECTION 6. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
