A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE, AMEND THE CERTIFICATE WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR IN THE GENERAL FUND (101)

WHEREAS, the Code Enforcement & Zoning Committee is requesting the addition of one (1) part-time Code Enforcement Inspector be added to the Code Enforcement Staff; and

WHEREAS, in order to accomplish this, additional funding is required to fund that position; and

WHEREAS, this additional position will be conducting Code Enforcement Inspections and functions of the Code Enforcement Program and be under the supervision of the Code Enforcement Director; and

WHEREAS, the additional funding will also allow for the purchase of one (1) additional vehicle for use by the Code Enforcement Department;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Appropriations with the County Auditor in the amount of Fifty-Two Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-Three Dollars (\$52,623.00) in the General Fund (101).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance in the amount of Fifty-Two Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-Three Dollars (\$52,623.00) into the following expense accounts:
