PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 63-19

A RESOLUTION TO CREATE A NEW FUND AND SET UP A REVENUE ACCOUNT & EXPENSE ACCOUNTS FOR COURT ELECTRONIC MONITORING FUND (249)

WHEREAS, the Fairfield County Commissioners are statutorily required to provide funding for the operation of the Fairfield County Jail; and

WHEREAS, the Fairfield County Commissioners will be sending intergovernmental revenues to the City of Lancaster for the explicit purpose to pay for electronic monitoring of criminal offenders by the Fairfield County Municipal Court which will provide alternative method to jail incarceration; and

WHEREAS, provision of these intergovernmental funds to the City of Lancaster for electronic monitoring of criminal offenders by the Fairfield County Municipal Court will result in a cost savings to the Fairfield County Commissioners by reducing the Fairfield County Jail population; and

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor establish a new fund for the Court Electronic Monitoring Fund (249) and create the following revenue and expense accounts:

Revenue:

249.000.4460 (County Reimb/Intergov Rev)

Expense:

249.250.5234 (Contractual Services)

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor establish the new Fund (249) Court Electronic Monitoring Fund with the County Auditor for the Certificate of Other Sources and Appropriations.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
