A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN ENGINEERING AGREEMENT FOR THE LAWRENCE STREET WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY UPGRADE PROJECT DESIGN

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster operates the Lawrence Street Water Pollution Control Facility; and

WHEREAS, the facility last received major improvements in 1998; and

WHEREAS, the City hired ARCADIS to evaluate the plant condition as well as improvements to meet NPDES permit requirements and provide safety and energy improvements; and

WHEREAS, ARCADIS has recommended approximately Twenty-One Million Dollars (\$21,000,000.00) in repairs and improvements at the plant; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to proceed with design for the improvements to allow construction in 2021;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director be and is hereby authorized to enter into a consulting engineering agreement not to exceed One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) for design and permitting services for the Lawrence Street Water Pollution Control Facility Upgrades.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
