

TEMPORARY RESOLUTION NO. 118-19

PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 114-19

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CMI FOR SOFTWARE FOR THE INCOME TAX DEPARTMENT, AND TO APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE IN THE INCOME TAX FUND (216), AND AMEND THE CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATIONS WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR

WHEREAS, the CMI software that the Income Tax Department is currently using was purchased in 1997, and has current application limitations, which need to be updated before the current version's support ceases;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with CMI for updated and expanded software for the Income Tax Department, in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Appropriations with the County Auditor in the amount of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) in Fund 216.

SECTION 3. That the City of Lancaster Auditor Appropriate from the unencumbered balance in the Income Tax Fund (216) into the following expense accounts:

216.160.5655, Software	<u>\$135,000.00</u>
TOTAL	\$150,000.00

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
