A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE FOR THE COLLECTION OF PAST DUE TAX DOLLARS AND NON-FILE DELINQUENCY ISSUES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §131.02, the Ohio Attorney General's Office can collect past due debt on behalf of political subdivisions that choose to participate; and

WHEREAS, the Income Tax Department would like to move forward at this time prior to the next tax season when the Department becomes very busy;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the Ohio Attorney General's Office to help with non-file delinquency issues and past due tax dollar issues.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from passage and approval by the Mayor.
