

TEMPORARY RESOLUTION NO. 79-20

PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO WAIVE COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND DECLARE AN EMERGENCY FOR THE ZANE ALLEY SANITARY SEWER REPAIR PROJECT, AND TO APPROVE ALL THEN AND NOW CERTIFICATES THAT MAY COME FROM THIS PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster discovered a sink hole in Zane Alley behind City Hall; and

WHEREAS, upon further video inspection of the sanitary sewer, the condition of the pipe has collapsed and is likely to cause further failures; and

WHEREAS, loss of the pipe and roadway will impact the operations of City Hall, City Hall Annex, and the Police Department; and

WHEREAS the Engineer's estimate for the work is Forty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$48,000.00), but underground conditions may increase the cost over the Fifty Thousand Dollar (\$50,000.00) limit for bidding; and

WHEREAS, if underground conditions increase the project costs above the statutory bidding amount, then this is an emergency condition obviating the need for formal bidding and advertising for contract pursuant to O.R.C. §735.051;

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the residents to eliminate the issues;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is authorized to waive the competitive bidding requirements and award a contract not to exceed Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000.00).

SECTION 2. That City Council approves the issuance of Then and Now Certificates pursuant to O.R.C. §735.051 for purchase orders for construction related to this work.

SECTION 3. That it is necessary to declare an emergency for the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens to replace the Zane Alley Sanitary Sewer and prevent further damage.
