A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT TO APPLY WITH COMMUNITY PARTNERS IN FAIRFIELD COUNTY FOR FUNDING FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD'S) FY20 LEAD HAZARD REDUCTION GRANT PROGRAM AND HEALTHY HOME SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING

WHEREAS, the minimum request is One Million Dollars from the Lead Hazard Reduction Grant; and

WHEREAS, the minimum request for Healthy Homes Supplemental Funding is Four Hundred Thousand Dollars; and

WHEREAS, this will be done by submitting a joint application with community partners such as the county, the City of Pickerington, Metro Housing and Community; and .

WHEREAS, this funding is for lead hazard reduction in homes with children under age six for both owner-occupied and rental homes; and

WHEREAS, suspension of this legislation is requested due to the application deadline for this funding is August 24th;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO.

SECTION 1. That the Community Development Department is hereby authorized to apply for funding with community partners in Fairfield County, from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD's) FY20 Lead Hazard Reduction Grant Program and Healthy Home Supplemental Funding.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
