A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT TO APPLY FOR FUNDING FROM THE U.S. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION (EDA'S) ECONOMIC ADJUSTMENT ASSISTANCE (EAA) PROGRAM

WHEREAS, EDA CARES Act Recovery Assistance is being administered under the authority of the EDA's Economic Adjustment Assistance (EAA) Program. Funding is available to support economic development, foster job creation, and attract private investment in economically distressed areas of the U.S.; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster is applying for Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000.00) toward studies related to planning for the implementation of the Ewing Street Connector to connect businesses on East Main Street and Fairfield Medical Center with US-33 and to minimize truck traffic in the downtown district; and

WHEREAS, a cost sharing match of 20%, Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00), of the total project cost is required;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Community Development Department is hereby authorized to apply for funding for the U.S. Economic Development (EDA's) Economic Adjustment Assistance (EAA) Program.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
