A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR A RATE STUDY OF WATER AND WASTEWATER RATES, CAPACITY FEES, AND SEPTAGE RECEIVING FEES

WHEREAS, the City is undertaking improvements to Water and Wastewater facilities;
and

WHEREAS, the City intends to pay for these projects with loans from the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund and the Safe Drinking Water Loan Fund as administered by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Water Development Agency; and

WHEREAS, the City has not reviewed capacity fees for either Water or Wastewater connections since 2007; and

WHEREAS, the Codified Ordinances of the City of Lancaster require periodic review of water and sewer rates to make sure rates are fair and equitable;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director be and is hereby authorized to enter into an engineering agreement not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$100,400.00) for the rate study.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
