A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE WILEY ROAD WATER LOOP PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster has completed plans for a water system improvement that will provide a looped feed to users along Wiley Road who are currently on a dead end line; and

WHEREAS, on July 23, 2021, the City advertised a public bid for this project, with the intent of beginning construction in the fall of 2021 and completing in early 2022;


BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is authorized to enter into a contract for the Wiley Road Water Loop Project in an amount not to exceed One Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,200,000.00).

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
