A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE LAWRENCE STREET CENTRAL FUEL DEPOT RELOCATION

WHEREAS, this upgrade to the fuel depot is necessary to meet Ohio EPA stormwater requirements; and

WHEREAS, due to flooding and site constraints at the existing fuel depot it was determined that relocation of the fuel depot to property adjacent to the salt bard is the better option; and

WHEREAS, due to supply chain issues, it would be advantageous to bid the project now for construction in 2022; and

WHEREAS, in order to finalize project costs and financing, the City would like to have a firm construction cost for the project;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is authorized to advertise for bids for the Lawrence Street Central Fuel Depot Relocation Project.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
