A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF LANCASTER TO APPLY FOR FUNDING FROM THE OHIO STATE CAPITAL BUDGET

WHEREAS, the Ohio Legislature is accepting proposals to fund capital projects from the State Budget for Fiscal Year 2023-2024; and

WHEREAS, funding is available to support the State's Administrative Building Fund; Adult and Juvenile Correctional Facilities; cultural and Sports Facilities; Natural Resources and Parks and Recreational Facilities; Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Facilities; and Higher Education Facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster is applying for Six Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand One Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars (\$677,168.00) toward the Trails at AHA! Project as a Natural Resources and Parks and Recreation Facility Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster is applying for Sixty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$69,500.00) toward the renovation of Lancaster City Hall's Historic Clock Tower as a Cultural and Sports Facilities Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster is also applying for Three Hundred Thirty-Four Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$334,600.00) toward the extension of the Lancaster Bike Path from Ety Road to Collins Road as a Natural Resources and Parks and Recreational Facilities Project;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster is hereby authorized to apply for funding from the Ohio Legislature.

SECTION 2. That Mayor David Scheffler is authorized to act on behalf of the City with respect to the request, including signing any award agreements.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
