PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 37-14

A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE AND AMEND THE CERTIFICATE WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR IN THE GENERAL FUND (101)

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster police officers are providing off duty security services for outside agencies and those agencies wish to pay the City of Lancaster instead of paying the officers directly so the City of Lancaster will need to appropriate the incoming money to pay the police officers for their work performed for the outside agencies. The City has created a new revenue and expense account to track all incoming and outgoing money for the special duty payments for the outside agencies;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO.

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Appropriations with the County Auditor in the amount of Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$55,000.00) in the General Fund (101).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the General Fund (101) unencumbered balance in the amount of Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$55,000.00) into expense account 101.325.5251 (Special Duty).

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from passage and approval by the Mayor.
