PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 79-22

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT A H2OHIO LEAD SERVICE LINE INVENTORY AND MAPPING GRANT AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio H2Ohio Grant Program provides financial assistance to political subdivisions to inventory and map lead water service lines; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster is required by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to identify potential lead service lines within the water system and develop a plan to deal with such lines by 2024; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has offered the City of Lancaster a grant in the amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) for a pilot project to develop a program to inventory and map lead water service lines;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized to accept a H2Ohio Lead Service Line Inventory and Mapping Grant and to execute contracts as required.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
