PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 46-14

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SERVICE SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT FOR A FINANCIAL CAPABILITY ASSESSMENT FOR THE COMBINED SEWER LONG TERM CONTROL PLAN

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster is mandated by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency to update the Combined Sewer System Long Term Control Plan; and

WHEREAS, compliance with the Combined Sewer System regulations has resulted in the expenditure of almost Seventy Million Dollars (\$70,000,000.00) and will require the expenditure of at least an additional Fifty Million Dollars (\$50,000,000.00) of rate payer funds; and

WHEREAS, the final compliance schedule for expending these funds will be based in part on the affordability and financial capability of the City;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO.

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is authorized to enter into a contract not to exceed Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000.00) for a detailed financial capability assessment for the Long Term Control Plan.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from passage and approval by the Mayor.
