

TEMPORARY RESOLUTION NO. 99-22

PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 96-22

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR AND APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE IN THE INDIGENT DRIVER ALCOHOL TREATMENT FUND (2032)

WHEREAS, the Fairfield County Municipal Court has a surplus of cash in its Indigent Driver Alcohol Treatment Fund (2032) and needs these funds to pay for contract services and drug and alcohol testing supplies; and

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2022, City Council passed Permanent Resolution 93-22 to appropriate One Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$130,000.00) into the Muni Court/Judicial/Drug Court/ADAMH Fund (2039), but did not appropriate One Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$130,000.00) from the unencumbered balance in the Indigent Driver Alcohol Treatment Fund (2032), nor amend the Certificate of Appropriation with the County Auditor;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Appropriations with the County Auditor in the amount of One Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$130,000.00) in the Indigent Driver Alcohol Treatment Fund (2032).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance in the Indigent Driver Alcohol Treatment Fund (2032) in expense account 2032.2500.59029 (Transfer to Muni Drug Court Fund) in the amount of One Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$130,000.00) so these funds can be used as previously authorized in PR 93-22 for Contractual Services (\$65,000.00 to 2039.2550.52034) and Supplies (\$65,000.00 to 2039.2550.53000).

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
