PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 101-22

A RESOLUTION TO INCREASE AND DECREASE APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1001) FOR CONTRACT SERVICES IN THE LAW DIRECTOR & CITY PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Law Director has had a vacant Assistant Prosecutor position for approximately nine (9) months and received no applications for that position upon posting; and

WHEREAS, the most recent posting attracted an excellent candidate who has prosecutorial experience as a licensed legal intern and has taken the Ohio bar exam, but has yet to receive his results; and

WHEREAS, the Law Director would like to hire said applicant on a contract basis to assist with the prosecutorial duties of the office in preparation for and anticipation of his passing the bar exam in October; and

WHEREAS, an increase in the contract services line item is necessary to fund this position;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor complete an appropriation decrease and increase for the following accounts:

DECREASE:

1001.2000.51002, Salaries/Staff/Law Director \$10,350.00

INCREASE:

1001.2000.52034, Contract Services \$10,350.00

SECTION 2. This resolution is declared to be an emergency measure, effective immediately upon passage and necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the City. Such emergency exists because there is a need to achieve and maintain adequate staffing levels to prosecute the adult misdemeanor traffic and criminal violations that are filed into the Fairfield County Municipal Court.
