PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 154-22

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF SIXTH AVENUE (MAPLE STREET TO CHERRY STREET) KNOWN AS FAI-CR502-1.34, PID 114406

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has planned the final phase of improvements to Sixth Avenue with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) to utilize Federal Surface Transportation Program Funds; and

WHEREAS, City Council previously passed Permanent Resolution 71-22 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a LPA Federal-Local Let Agreement with ODOT for the purpose of constructing these improvements known as FAI-CR502-1.34, PID 114406; and

WHEREAS, these improvements are expected to cost approximately One Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,200,000.00);

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the improvement of Sixth Avenue (Maple Street to Cherry Street), known as FAI-CR502-1.34, PID 114406, in an amount not to exceed One Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,200,000.00).

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
