A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF LANCASTER TO APPLY FOR FUNDING FROM THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO ANY AND ALL AGREEMENTS NECESSARY FOR CONSIDERATION AND AWARD OF THE STATE OF OHIO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT CORONAVIRUS (CDBG-CV) FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Development is accepting applications for State of Ohio CDBG-CV funds allocated through the Federal CARES Act to address Covid-19 impacts; and

WHEREAS, funding is available to support public services and public facilities in Ohio to prevent, prepare for, and respond to Covid-19; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster Community Development Department will hold two public hearings and accept applications from eligible entities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster Community Development will apply for up to Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) to fund qualifying projects; and

WHEREAS, if awarded, ten percent (10%) of the grant funding will be available for administrative costs; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster is hereby authorized to apply for funding from the Ohio Department of Development for State of Ohio CDBG-CV funds.

SECTION 2. That Lynda Berge Disser, Director of Community Development is hereby authorized to apply for a grant on behalf of the City of Lancaster, and that Mayor David Scheffler be authorized to act on behalf of the City of Lancaster and enter into any and all agreements required for consideration and award of State of Ohio CDBG-CV Funds.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
