PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 48-23

A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE IN THE CEMETERY FUND (2007) AND TO AMEND THE CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATIONS WITH THE FAIRFIELD COUNTY AUDITOR FOR THE PURCHASE OF MOWING AND TRIMMING EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, the Cemetery Department annually competitively bids out mowing and trimming at all City cemeteries; and

WHEREAS, in 2023, the contract to mow and trim Maple Grove Cemetery was not awarded due to no bids being received; and

WHEREAS, in order for the Cemetery Department to meet its maintenance obligations at Maple Grove Cemetery, one (1) new mower and four (4) new string trimmers must be purchased before the mowing season begins; and

WHEREAS, the necessary equipment is available through the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Program and in stock at a local vendor; and

WHEREAS, this new equipment purchase was unexpected, and not budgeted for 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Cemetery Department is requesting an appropriation from the Cemetery Fund (2007) in the amount of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) for the purchase of one (1) Scag Cheeta II Zero-Turn Mower at a cost of Thirteen Thousand Dollars (\$13,000.00), four (4) Stihl FS 56-RC String Trimmers at a cost of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00), and spare parts such as blades, string, reels, belts, and other items needed for maintenance and supplies; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Appropriations with the County Auditor for the Cemetery Fund (2007) in the amount of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance in expense account 2007.4200.56030 (Equipment - Cemetery) in the amount of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) in the Cemetery Fund (2007) for the purchase of one (1) Scag Cheeta II Zero-Turn Mower at a cost of Thirteen Thousand Dollars (\$13,000.00), four (4) Stihl FS 56-RC String Trimmers at a cost of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00), and spare parts such as blades, string, reels, belts, and other items needed for maintenance and supplies.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
