

TEMPORARY RESOLUTION NO. 54-23

PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 51-23

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION AND OTHER SOURCES WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR, APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE, INCREASE RECEIPTS IN THE MUNICIPAL COURT PROBATION FUND (2035), AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Fairfield County Municipal Court has been awarded an Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services (OMHAS) Housing Grant, paid through the Fairfield County ADAMH Board in the amount of Nine Thousand Dollars (\$9,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the funding must be expended prior to June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Court has identified the vendors (landlords and utility companies) that will be paid from the grant funding and is requesting that the new revenue be appropriated to allow them to be expend the grant funding before June 30, 2023; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Appropriation and Other Sources with the County Auditor in the amount of Nine Thousand Dollars (\$9,000.00) in the Municipal Court Probation Fund (2035).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor increase receipts in revenue account 2035.2540.43027 (Probation/Mental Health Court) in the amount of Nine Thousand Dollars (\$9,000.000).


SECTION 3. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance in the Municipal Court Probation Fund (2035) the sum of Nine Thousand Dollars (\$9,000.00) in the following expense accounts:

2035.2540.53006, Utilities Payments	\$1,546.00
2035.2540.59014, Transfer to Lancaster Utilities	\$ <u>554.00</u>
TOTAL	\$9,000.00

SECTION 4. This resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety, and welfare of this City and is required to be immediately effective to ensure prompt application of funds to assist in abating homelessness as a result of the opioid epidemic, wherefore this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by City Council and approval by the Mayor.
