PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 63-23

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE 2023 SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, City Council previously authorized contracts with professional engineering firm EMH&T to perform an investigation and condition assessment of various storm and sanitary sewers in the City in both 2021 and 2023; and

WHEREAS, these investigations revealed that various City sewers are in poor condition and in need of rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, the most effective technique for the needed sewer rehabilitation is the installation of a cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) liner; and

WHEREAS, the City is planning to publicly bid the 2023 Sewer Rehabilitation Project in the summer of 2023, and will need to enter into a contract with the successful bidder to have the CIPP installed; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the construction of the 2023 Sewer Rehabilitation Project in an amount not to exceed One Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,250,000.00).

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
