A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN ENGINEERING AGREEMENT FOR ENGINEERING DESIGN FOR CONCENTRATE LINE UPGRADES

WHEREAS, the Concentrate Line from the South Water Plant has undergone cleaning and evaluation to deal with pressure issues that limit the production at the South Water Plant; and

WHEREAS, the work to date has temporarily cleaned the line and allowed increased production; and

WHEREAS, evaluation of long term solutions to the operation of the concentrate line was completed based on the results of the cleaning; and

WHEREAS, the City is ready to design modifications to the concentrate line to maintain operations; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to enter into an engineering agreement not to exceed Two Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$210,000.00) for the design and bidding of the project.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
