A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN ENGINEERING AGREEMENT FOR THE DESIGN OF THE EAST MAIN STREET SEWER SEPARATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permits with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) require the construction of a sewer separation project along East Main Street near Baldwin Run; and

WHEREAS, the City commissioned a feasibility study to determine the scope of sewer separation that is possible in this area; and

WHEREAS, the feasibility study is complete and the City is ready to move into the final design phase of the project; and

WHEREAS, the Stormwater Department anticipates that the funds for this project will come from unencumbered balance in the Stormwater Sewer Fund (6006) and the Stormwater Utility Reserve Fund (6019) through a separate resolution to come before Council at a later date; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to enter into an engineering agreement not to exceed Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00) for final design services on the East Main Street Sewer Separation Project.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
