A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF LANCASTER TO APPLY FOR SUPPLEMENTAL COMMUNITY HOUSING IMPACT AND PRESERVATION – LEAD ABATEMENT PROGRAM (CHIP-LAP) FUNDING FROM THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Development (Development) has made Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) in American Rescue Plan Act and State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds available to leverage funding to current CHIP Programs, to eliminate lead-based paint hazards in homes currently receiving CHIP Program Assistance; and

WHEREAS, supplemental funds will be available on a competitive basis to CHIP Program grantees, including program year (PY) 2023 CHIP applicants, for CHIP-LAP activities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster Community Development Department will apply for Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00) per project (estimated One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00)) of supplemental funding for CHIP housing rehabilitation projects; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster is hereby authorized to apply for funding from the Ohio Department of Development for CHIP-LAP Funds.

SECTION 2. That the Community Development Department is hereby authorized to apply for a grant on behalf of the City of Lancaster, and if awarded, Mayor David Scheffler is hereby authorized to act on behalf of the City of Lancaster and enter into any and all agreements required for consideration and award of State of Ohio CHIP-LAP Funds.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
