A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO
ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE FETTERS RUN OHIO UNIVERSITY –
LANCASTER STREAM RESTORATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) Water Resource Restoration Sponsor Program (WRRSP) provides financial assistance, in the form of interest from Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) Program Loans to political subdivision for restoration projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster has prepared construction plans for a Feters Run stream restoration project on Ohio University Lancaster (OU-L) property in order to protect both private and public infrastructure and improve water quality downstream of the site; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvements along Feters Run are anticipated to cost approximately One Million Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,700,000.00) to construct, and the cost will be covered entirely by the WRRSP; and

WHEREAS, the City is currently planning to publicly bid this rehabilitation project in the late summer of 2023 and construct the project in the winter of 2023 and 2024; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the Feters Run OU-L Stream Restoration Project.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
