PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 82-23

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF LANCASTER TO APPLY FOR GRANT FUNDING FROM THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio was recently awarded Thirteen Million Dollars (\$13,000,000.00) from the federal Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act and Eight Million Dollars (\$8,000,000.00) of this grant money is being earmarked for their "Ohio Community Program"; and

WHEREAS, this grant program is specifically for local government buildings that are in need of energy efficient upgrades; and

WHEREAS, the minimum monetary request is Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) with no matching funds required; and

WHEREAS, the City has already conducted an energy audit of all its buildings and will use the energy audit to determine the projects for its funding request; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the City Administration is hereby authorized to apply for and act on behalf of the City of Lancaster and execute any and all agreements required for consideration and award of an Ohio Community Program Grant.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
