PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 88-23

A RESOLUTION TO INCREASE RECEIPTS AND APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE, AND AMEND THE CERTIFICATE WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR IN THE GENERAL FUND (1001)

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster Fire Department received grant approval for ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act) First Responder Wellness, Recruitment, Retention and Resiliency Grant, CFDA 21.027/Pass Through State ID Grant DPSFE270; and

WHEREAS, the Grant offers retention incentives to encourage First Responders to remain in their chosen fields; and

WHEREAS, this retention incentive is for eligible employees whose annual base salary on June 17, 2022 equaled or exceeded Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00); and

WHEREAS, each eligible employee will receive a maximum of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) from these Grant funds; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Other Sources in the General Fund (1001) in the amount of Two Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$280,000.00) and Appropriations with the County Auditor in the amount of Two Hundred Eighty-Four Thousand Sixty Dollars (\$284,060.00) in the General Fund (1001).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor increase receipts in the Federal Grant line item account number 1001.0000.43013 (Federal Grant) in the amount of Two Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$280,000.00).

SECTION 3. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance in expense account:

1001.3500.51002, Fire Salaries/Fire Staff	\$280,000.00
1001.3500.51053, Medicare	\$ <u>4,060.00</u>
TOTAL	\$284,060.00

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
